DURING THE PROCESS OF THESE CLASSES:

During the process of these classes all students will be required to participate in offsite Fashion Showcases including Traveling Fashion Showcases and will participate in Bella Faire's Annual Fashion Runway Showcase. The student models in the classes will be featured in the opening of the Annual Showcase to display their skills and all they have learned in class.
